Minutes of the Development Plan and Zoning By-Law Amendment hearing Tuesday, April 23, 2024 at 7:00pm in the Municipal Council Chambers, Vita, Manitoba

The purpose of the public hearing was to hear representations from any persons who wish to make them in respect to the following matters:

- 1. By-law No. 196-2024 Being an amendment to *The R.M. of Stuartburn Development Plan By-Law No.* 186-2022 To re-designate a portion of land in the area generally described as being part of the SW ¼ 21-3-8E from Agriculture to Rural Residential
- 2. By-law No. 197-2024 Being an amendment to *The R.M. of Stuartburn Zoning By-law No.* 157-2019 To rezone a portion of land in the area generally described as being part of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 21-3-8E from Agriculture to Rural Residential

The public hearing was held in person and published as per the requirements under *The Planning Act and The Municipal Act.*

No one registered to attend the public hearing nor did anyone submit anything in writing.

- Zoning By-law Amendment If Council deems the proposed re-zoning be in compliance with the Development plan and is satisfied with the representations made during the public hearing, then they will not object to council giving 2nd reading to the by-law.
